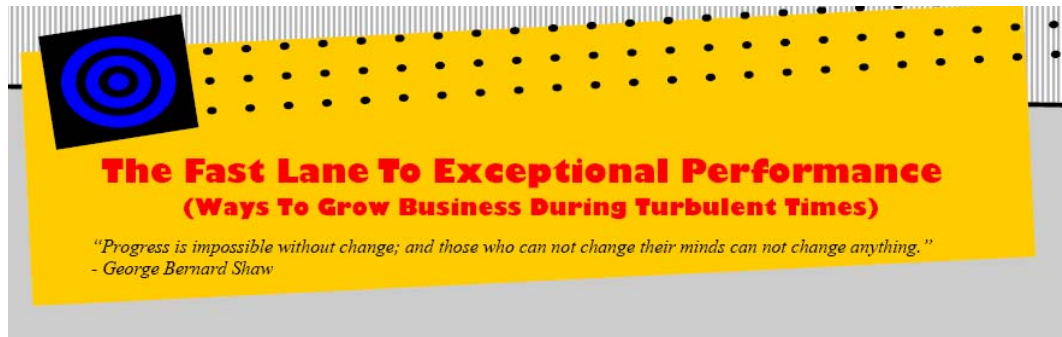

### Directions to Holiday Inn

**From I-90 East** Exit south on Elmhurst Road, turn right on Landmeier Road and proceed to hotel.

**From O'Hare Airport** Proceed from terminals and go north on Manheim Road (Rt.45) to Higgins Road (Rt.72) turn left (west) on Higgins, then turn left on Landmeier Road. Cross Busse Road (Rt.83) and entrance is on left side.

**From Downtown Chicago** Take I-90/94 west (Kennedy Expressway) to I-90 west (follow signs for Rockford) exit Elmhurst Road South. Take Elmhurst Road South, then take a right on Landmeier Road and the hotel entrance is on the left side.

**From Indiana & South** Take I-294 north to I-290 west. Exit Rt.83 north (Rt. 83 will also be called Klingery or Busse Highway) . Take a left on Landmeier and entrance is on left side.

-OR-

Take I-90/94 west (Kennedy Expressway) to I-90 west (follow signs for Rockford), exit Elmhurst Road South. Proceed on Elmhurst Road and take a right on Landmeier Road, cross Busse Road and entrance is on left side.

**From the Milwaukee area and far north suburbs** Take I-94 South to I-294 South to I-90 West (follow signs for Rockford), exit Elmhurst Road South. Proceed on Elmhurst Road, then take a right on Landmeier Road, cross Busse Road and entrance is on left side.

**From the West** Take I-90 East to Arlington Heights Road South. Turn left on Landmeier Road, hotel entrance is right before Busse Road on right side.
